

MEASUREMENTS AND PAYMENTS

PART 1 - UNIT PRICE

A. Measurement

1. Vehicles transporting municipal liquid sludge from the Wastewater Treatment Plant which are carrying their full rated capacity will not be measured, but the gallons full rated capacity will be recorded. If these vehicles are not full, measurements will be made by the following method:
 - a. The dimensions of the liquid tanker will be recorded.
 - b. A scale graduated in inches will be inserted into the sludge and the depth will be read to the nearest inch. Three (3) such measurements will be read to the nearest inch.
 - c. The average of these readings will be converted to gallons.

B. Recording Measurements for Payment

1. The following forms will be used for the purpose of recording sludge volumes hauled from the Wastewater Treatment Plant, and it will be the basis of payment for this work. These forms will be supplied by the Owner. Quantities will be entered by a representative of the Owner, and the completed form should be submitted to the Owner daily. In addition, the Contractor must present the Owner with a receipt verifying that each truck load of material hauled under this Contract was disposed at an approved location. The Contractor must submit one (1) receipt for each day's operation. All receipts must be dated and signed by a representative of the disposal or utilization location and submitted daily.

PART 2 - WAIVER OF CLAIMS

A. The making and acceptance of final payment shall constitute:

1. A waiver of all claims by Owner against Contractor other than those arising from unsettled Liens, from faulty or defective Work, or from failure to comply with the requirements of the Contract Documents or the terms of any special guarantees specified therein.
2. A waiver of all claims by Contractor against Owner other than those previously made in writing and still unsettled.
